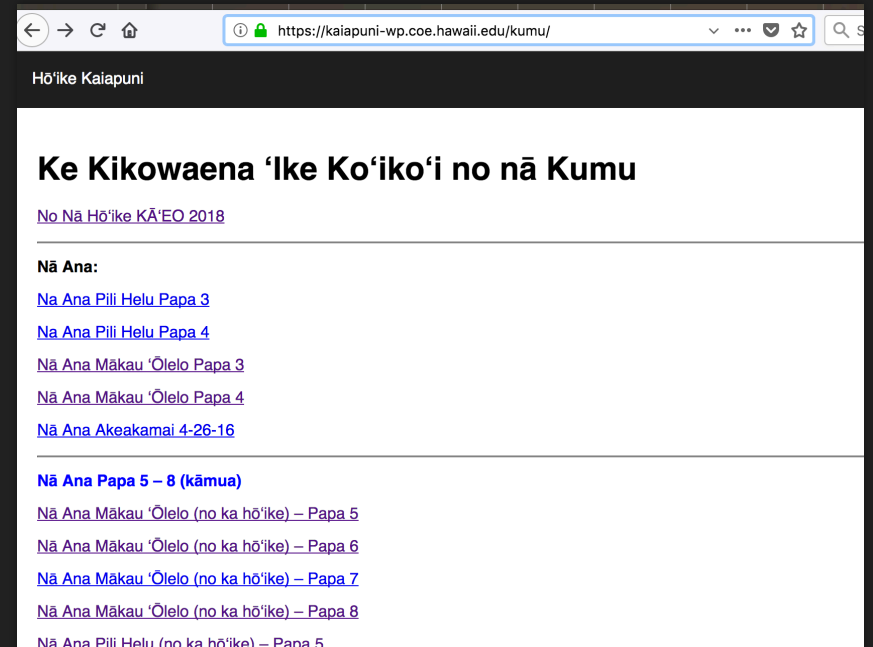

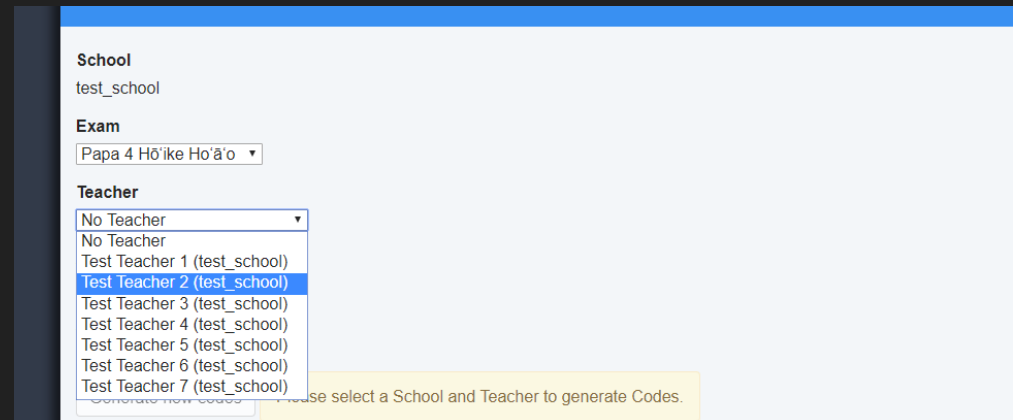

## New features this year

### Generating Student codes

- Like last year, students will use 1 code per test.
- Students are now divided by classrooms, so Test Administrators will generate codes by classroom teacher

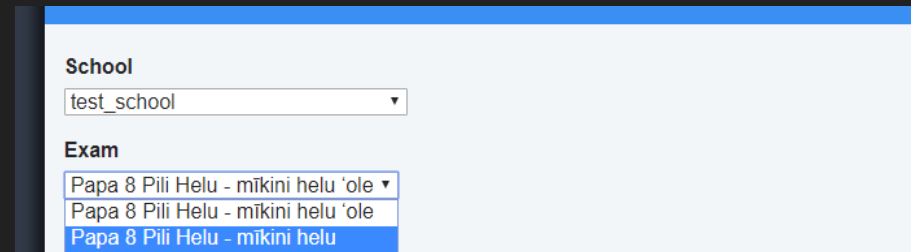

## New features this year

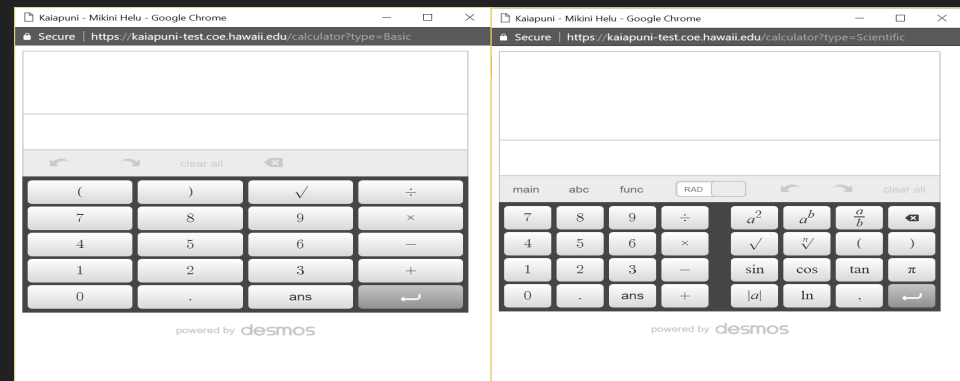
### Calculator use

- For grades 6-8 Mathematics tests, there are questions where calculator use is allowed.
- They are listed as separate math tests and taken as separate tests, but scores will be combined into 1 test for analysis and reporting
- **Please note:** It is important that the calculator is closed and the browser quit properly so that students cannot use a calculator in a section of the test where it is not allowed

## External validity study

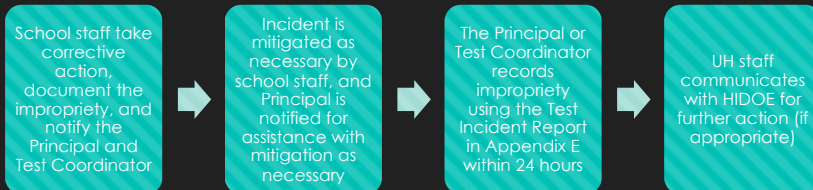
- No external validity study will be conducted this year for Grades 3 & 4, since it was completed after the 2017 administration

- If the tests are operational field tests in 2019, an external validity study will be conducted for Grades 5-8



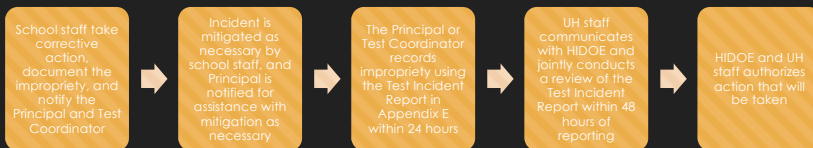

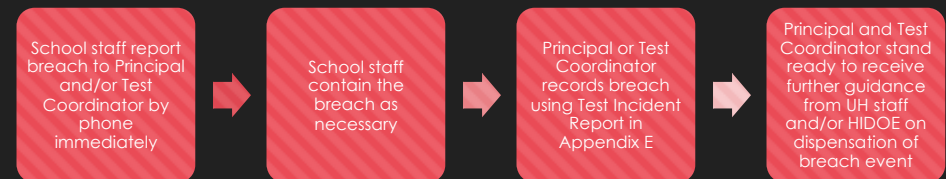
